

POTTER FUNERAL SERVICES TODAY

Pioneer Resident of Southwest Taken by Death

Funeral services will be held at 4 p. m. Monday from St. Clements Episcopal Church for Herbert L. Potter, florist, who died yesterday at a local hospital. He was 68.

Rev. C. H. Horner will officiate at services. Burial will be in Masonic Cemetery under the direction of Kaster & Maxon Mortuary.

Mr. Potter came to the Southwest while a young man from Waupun, Wis., after graduation from Northwestern University.

He settled in Carlsbad, N. M., while it was known as Eddy. There he held the offices of Postmaster, County Commissioner and Commissioner of Peace.

He moved to El Paso 35 years ago and entered the drug business. He was part owner of Potter & White Drug Co.

About 13 years ago he entered the floral business. During 1929 he was president of the State Floral Assn.

Mr. Potter was a member of St. Clements Church, Lodge No. 130, A. F. & A. M.; the Scottish Rite, the Shrine, the Rotary Club, and El Paso Lodge 187 of the Elks.

He lived at 3615 Hueco St. Mr. Potter was unmarried and had no near relative living. His sister, with whom he operated Potter Floral Co., died February.
