

Funeral Of Former Champion Is Held

Funeral services for Edward Price, 61 years old, who died at Providence hospital Friday morning after an extended illness, were held in the Peak-Hagedon chapel, 506 Texas street, this afternoon. The services were private because of Price's request before his death. Burial was in Concordia cemetery.

Mr. Price was born in Troy, N. Y., in 1860. He was for some time heavyweight boxing champion of the Pacific coast and at one time conducted a boxing school in San Bernardino, Calif.

The dead man is survived by his wife and the following children: Miss Florenz Price, Mrs. W. E. Nordin and a son, J. E. Healy, who is now in St. Louis.
