

EL PASO PIONEER TAKEN BY DEATH

John Frederick Price Was
Resident 51 Years

Funeral arrangements were pending today with Hartford Mortuary for John Frederick Price who died Saturday at his home at 904 Upson avenue. He was 65.

Mr. Price, a pioneer El Pasoan, was a traveling auditor for the American Smelting & Refining Co. He had been employed by the concern for 35 years.

He was born in San Antonio Feb. 18, 1873, and came to El Paso when he was 14. He worked for several years for Price Bros. The firm was located on the present site of the Ellaray Theater. Then he went to Mexico where he was engaged in the mining business until he went to work for the American Smelting & Refining Co.

Mr. Price was a member of Volunteer Fire Co. No. 2. He belonged to the Knights of Columbus.

Survivors include his widow, two daughters, Sister Mary Price of New Orleans, La., and Mrs. L. P. de Garcia of Mexico City, and three sons, John F. Price Jr., and Joseph V. Price, both of El Paso, and Herbert H. Price, of Mexico City.

Mr. Price had been ill for about three months.
