Mark E. Price.

Mark E. Price of "The Price Dairy" of this city, died yesterday in Denver. He had been in poor health for some time, having never wholly recovered from an operation for appendicitis at a local hospital in this city some months ago. After leaving the hospital he went to California for a short time and then he left for Colorado, feeling somewhat improved, but soon grew worse. He was expected home in a short time but the family was notified by telegram about midnight last night of his death. The body will be shipped to the family cemetery in Ohio for interment.

Mr. Price's wife is a sister of Dr. Robert Bruce Smith, pastor of the First Baptist church. He moved to this vicinity nearly four years ago. He leaves a wife and five boys, the youngest being four years of age. Mr. Price belonged to a remarkable family of scholars and professional men. One brother is the dean of Mebrew and Semitic languages in the University of Chicago, another is the president of Ottawa university, another brother is president of the famous Pilsbury academy, another is dean in the University of Ohio, another is a lawyer in Chicago, and another is pastor of one of the leading Baptist churches in Michigan. They were of Welsh parentage.
