

## HARRY RAMEY IS SMALLPOX VICTIM

Harry T. Ramey, a prominent real estate dealer of El Paso, died Friday night at a local hospital of smallpox, following a short illness.

The deceased was born 28 years ago at Warrenton, Va., at which place he resided until two years ago, when he came to El Paso. Prior to coming to this city he was cashier of the Fortiur National bank. Upon taking up his home in El Paso he entered the real estate business, and with his brother, R. A. Ramey, formed the firm of Ramey Bros.

Mr. Ramey is survived by his wife, his brother and an uncle, Dr. R. L. Ramey, and by his mother and sister, who reside at Cupepper, Va.

He was a member of the Masonic lodge at Warrenton. The remains were interred in Evergreen cemetery Saturday afternoon.
