## Prominent Banker.

As son of the late Jefferson Ray-

nolds, he was prominent in bank-  
ing interests of the southwest hav-  
ing acted as cashier and vice presi-  
dent of the First National Bank of  
Las Vegas, cashier of the First Na-  
tional Bank of El Paso, and as-  
sistant treasurer of the United Sugar  
Companies of Mexico.

He is survived by his widow,  
Esther, two sons, Edward and  
Thomas, of Buffalo, a daughter, Mrs.  
L. E. Hardway of El Paso, a grand-  
son, L. E. Hardway, Jr., of this city,  
and a twin brother, Hallett of El  
Paso.
