

Mrs. Reckhart, E. P. Pioneer, Dies At 78

died Wednesday afternoon in her
residence, 3130 Aurora Street. She
was born in Pennsylvania in 1870
and came out to Fort Cragg, N. M.,
in 1888 with her father, the late
Capt. John Crawford, who was
called the "Poet Scout" and suc-
ceeded Buffalo Bill as an Indian
Scout.

In 1895 she was married to the
late Dan W. Reckhart who died in
1920 after having served as per-
petual president and originator of
the old McGinty Club. He was also
one of the original members of El
Paso Volunteer Fire Department.
Mrs. Reckhart was a member of the
Episcopal Church and belonged to
the Women's Pioneer Club. She is
survived by one daughter, Mrs. W.
E. Sherry, El Paso, and a sister,
Mrs. Mae Brechtel of Albuquerque,
N. M. Funeral arrangements were

Mortuary.
