

## Mrs. Rey, El Paso Pioneer, Is Dead

Mrs. Paulina Escajeda Rey, 84, daughter of a pioneer El Paso valley family, died at the family residence, 631 Prospect avenue, yesterday morning. She had been in ill health for several weeks.

Mrs. Rey was born at Guadalupe, in the lower Juarez valley. As a child her father, Francisco Escajeda, moved across the Rio Grande and was one of the founders of the town of San Elizario. She remembered the days in which settlers in the valley frequently were forced to fight off hostile Indian raiders.

She moved with her family to El Paso 22 years ago to provide her children with better educational advantages and remained here until her death. She is survived by three sons, Pedro, Cruz and Jose Maria Rey, and one daughter, Mrs. Paulina Rey Provencia.

Funeral services will be held at the family residence at 9:30 a. m. today. Burial will be in the family plot at San Elizario.
