

Wells Fargo Driver Dies In California

Stephen Houston Rogers, a resident of El Paso 70 years, before moving to California four years ago, died Monday in Los Angeles.

Mr. Rogers once drove for the Wells Fargo Co. and later was employed as an engineer for the Southern Pacific Railroad.

Before El Paso had its own water supply system, Mr. Rogers hauled water in from Deming and sold it.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. George Wood, of El Paso, and a son, J. B. Rogers, of Los Angeles.
