

A Sad Death.

Selma Rosenheim, of Paso del Norte, died April 13th, at 9 a. m. of scarlet fever. She was buried yesterday at the Jewish cemetery alongside the deceased Mrs. Rothschild, as was her wish.

Her funeral was largely attended, there being a representative from every Jewish house in El Paso.

The funeral service was conducted by Mr. I. Hass, of El Paso.

Miss Rosenheim was stricken down in the midst of a happy life, and on the eve of the realization of the brightest womanly hopes. She intended to return to Germany in May to be married. When she was attacked with sickness, the services of Dr. Ponce of Paso del Norte, and Dr. Irvin of El Paso, were procured, but the unremitting services of these two excellent physicians were of no avail, and death quickly released her from suffering.

Miss Rosenheim had a large circle of friends both American and Mexican, who will sincerely regret her early and unexpected death.
