

POLICEMAN ROSS DEAD.

He Expired at the Hotel Dieu Early This Morning.

Policeman Robert Ross died at the Hotel Dieu at 1:10 o'clock this morning, after a sickness of several weeks. He had been a sufferer from appendicitis for a long time and was taken to the hospital to undergo an operation. He sank rapidly to his end, and his death had been expected every hour for several days.

Mr. Ross was appointed to the police force by Mayor Magoffin some two years ago. He was an able and efficient officer and second to none in fidelity and devotion to his duties. All his brother officers speak in the highest terms of him. He was quiet, modest and unassuming and never sought notoriety, and was always content with the knowledge that he had done his duty.

The deceased leaves a wife and several small children to mourn his loss. In her bereavement Mrs. Ross will have the heart-felt sympathy of her late husband's many friends.

He Expired Last Night at the Sisters' Hospital.

Policeman Robert Ross is dead. He expired at Hotel Dieu a little after 1 o'clock this morning, having been ill for several weeks. His death was mainly due to an operation for appendicitis which was performed some time since, after which his constitution seemed to give away and he sank rapidly.

Officer Ross had been on the police force about two years and during that time made a record for efficient service second to no other man on the force.
