DEATHS AND BURIALS.

Judge J. E. Rowland.

Judge J. E. Rowland, a resident of El Paso county for the past 26 or 27 years, died yesterday at Ysleta and was buried this morning in Evergreen cemetery, El Paso. The funeral services were held this morning in the old church at Ysleta and the remains were then brought to El Paso and interred. Deceased leaves a wife and three children, a boy and two girls, the youngest about 7 years of age. Nagley & Kaster have charge of the final arrangements.

Judge Rowland was a native of Kentucky and during the civil war was of the command of Gen. Forrest, the Confederate raider. After the war he came to Texas and about 27 years ago came to El Paso, where he lived until about ten years ago, when he moved to Ysleta. He was justice of the peace at Ysleta for several years and was one of the best known men to the old timers, in the

valley.
