Funeral Services Today For Mrs. Anna Rush

Funeral services for Mrs. Anna Rush, resident of the El Paso vicinity 47 years, were to be held from the Peak-Hagedon Chapel today at 4 p. m. She died yesterday at her home at 3730 Nations St. She was 93.

Mrs. Rush was the grandmother of Billy Rush, 17, selected as the best all-around cowboy at The Herald-Post Kid's Rodeo in 1934.

Mrs. Rush was born in Pike County, Ill., and came to Carlsbad, N. M., in 1887. She was one of the oldest El Paso pioneers.

Rev. Sam E. Allison was to officiate at the services. Burial was to be in Restlawn Cemetery.
