GIST RUSSELL DIES SUDDENLY IN EAST

Gist Russell, who was born and reared in this city, died Thursday in Baltimore, Md. Diabetes was the cause of death.

Russell, who was 22 years old, was the son of Mrs. J. H. Russell. He was educated here and for a time was employed by the State National bank, later entering the office of A. P. Coles & Bros. He then became connected with the Tobin Realty company.

Following the death of Mr. Tobin, Mr. Russell, together with Harold Kilburn, took over the business, forming the firm of Kilburn & Russell. He was a member of this firm at the time of

his death.

About 10 days ago Mr. Russell became ill and he was taken by his mother to Baltimore to consult with eastern specialists. The funeral will be held in Boston, Mass., where Mrs. Russell has a number of relatives.

His father was cashier of the State National bank when he died.
