
SUDDEN DEATH OF ALBERT SCHUTZ

An Old Timer Here, Having Come Here Forty Years Ago.—Family a Prominent One.

Albert Schutz, one of El Paso's oldest citizens, died suddenly this afternoon at 2:45 of apoplexy at his residence, 506 North El Paso street. Mr. Schutz was taken sick this morning but no serious results were anticipated.

He came to El Paso in the early sixties with his uncle Samuel, and with his brother Solomon was for a great many years in the dry goods business. In late years he has conducted a brokerage and commission firm. He leaves a wife and two children, Felix, a student at the University of Michigan, and a daughter who was married this past winter to a business man of Kalamazoo, Mich.

Mr. Schutz was a nephew of Samuel and a brother of Solomon and Max Schutz. No arrangements have been made for the funeral.
