

Adele Schwartz, arts patron, dies

Adele F. Schwartz, wife of The Popular Vice President Albert Schwartz, died Tuesday.

Mrs. Schwartz, of 1001 Blanchard, was a Galveston native who moved to El Paso in 1941 after her marriage to Mr. Schwartz. The two met as students at the University of Texas.

She was a member of the board of trustees of Temple Mount Sinai and Sisterhood of Temple Mount Sinai, for which she served as president from 1959-61. She was vice president of the National Council of Jewish Women, and a member of the Pan American Roundtable, the El Paso Symphony Guild and the El Paso Museum of Art Guild.

Survivors include her husband; two sons, Maurice A. Schwartz, Stinson Beach, Calif., and James F. Schwartz, El Paso; a daughter, Nancy Schechter of Dallas; her mother, Pyrlé A. Friedner of El Paso; and five grandchildren.

Funeral services will be Thursday at 11 a. m. at Temple Mount Sinai, with Rabbi Edward L. John and Dr. Floyd S. Fierman officiating. Burial will be in Mount Sinai Cemetery.
