

Henry W. Seamon Taken by Death

Henry W. Seamon, 72, prominent in Southwestern and Mexican mining circles for 40 years, died Tuesday in Lakeland, Fla. He was the son of the late Professor W. H. Seamon, for many years head of the departments of geology and metallurgy at Texas Western college. He is also the nephew of Mrs. Frank H. Seamon of El Paso. He is survived by his widow, Fanny Seamon of Lakeland and his sister Mrs. Isabel Chalmers of Charlottesville, Va. Services were held in Lakeland.
