

## MRS. R. C. SEMPLE DIES IN PNEUMONIA ATTACK

Mrs. R. C. Semple, wife of alderman Semple, died at her home, 2733 Gold street, Tuesday night from pneumonia.

Mrs. Semple was 33 years old and a daughter of postmaster H. A. Shelton, who moved here from Mississippi 32 years ago. Eleven years form the period of her married life, during which she had been prominent in club work, especially for young girls; and until recently, when the birth of a child prohibited, she was active in Red Cross work.

The flag over the city hall where alderman Semple has his office, was at half mast Wednesday.

Those surviving besides the widower and parents are, son, Richard; daughter, Anna; a three weeks old baby girl; sisters, Mrs. W. D. Howe and Mrs. Maury Kemp.

Capt. Richard F. Burges, who has done distinguished service in France, is a brother-in-law of decedent.

The funeral will start from the residence Thanksgiving morning at 9 o'clock, Rev. W. M. Fairly officiating. Interment will be in Evergreen cemetery.
