

Mrs. Sharp's Rites Today; Was Pioneer

Funeral services for Mrs. Margaret Jane Sharp, 87, a resident of El Paso for 63 years, who died Wednesday in her home at 505 Upson Avenue, will be held at 11 a. m. Saturday in Hagedon-Harding Funeral Home.

Mrs. Sharp came here from Kentucky in 1884. A year later, she was married to the late William E. Sharp, who became chief examiner of U. S. Customs service here. She died in her home, which she and her husband built in 1887.
