

Mrs. Shaver Funeral Set Thursday

Funeral services for Mrs. Lucille Smith Shaver, 700 Wellesley, who died Tuesday, will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Harding-Orr and McDaniel McDaniel Montana Chapel, with Dr. Brodace Elkins officiating. Burial will be in Evergreen.

She had lived in El Paso all her life and attended Ed Bailey school and graduated from El Paso High School. She had a degree from the University of Missouri and taught mathematics at El Paso High School for approximately 40 years.

She married Robert Melvin Shaver, the pioneer head of the U.S. Weather Service, and until her death, lived at the home they bought in Kern Place 43 years ago.

On her retirement from teaching she became active in the National Retired Teachers' Association. She held office in the national, state and local associations and was president of the local chapter for six years. She was a member of the Comadre Club, the Women's Pioneer Club and at the time of her death, was president of the Kern Place Garden Club.

She is survived by her sister, Miss Juanita Smith, El Paso; a niece, Mrs. Thalia Smith Rau, Santa Monica, Calif.; a great niece, Mrs. Sandra Rau Irons, Torrance, Calif. and two nephews, Robert T. Shaver, Cocoa Beach, Fla. and Dr. Ben Shaver, San Antonio, Tex. All of these and their spouses will be in El Paso for the funeral services.
