

Sheriff's Posse Manager Dies

Funeral services for Gladstone Morley Shaw, manager of the El Paso Sheriff's Posse and formerly identified with the world's leading circus, will be held at 10 a. m. tomorrow in Kaster and Maxon Chapel.

Rev. Malcolm N. Twiss will officiate. Burial will be in Masonic Cemetery with services by Fraternity Lodge No. 1111.

Mr. Shaw was 66.

He was born in New York state and began his circus career with Barnum and Bailey in 1908. He was in the legal department.

Later he was with the Ringling Brothers, Hagenback and Wallace, Sells Floto and Tom Mix circuses.

Thirty-three years ago he married a circus horseback rider, Miss Charlotte Vandreau.

In 1939 Mr. and Mrs. Shaw came to El Paso with the Tom Mix circus, and remained here.

Mr. Shaw was a member of the Masonic Lodge of Boston and the Scottish Rite Bodies and El Maida Shrine of El Paso.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Charlotte Shaw; and a sister, Miss Elizabeth Shaw of Kansas City.
