

Shedd Funeral To Be Held Today

Funeral services for I. A. Shedd, 68, a resident of El Paso for 37 years, who died at Masonic hospital yesterday morning of peritonitis, will be held at 4 p. m. today at Kester & Maxon chapel with Rev. A. A. Hyde and Rev. W. S. Huggett officiating. Burial will be at Restlawn.

Mr. Shedd was a pioneer in the lumber business here. He also had a wide acquaintance in Arizona, where he lived before coming to El Paso in 1895.

After coming to El Paso from Tucson he became manager of the old International Lumber company. In 1906 he organized the El Paso Sash & Door company.

Mr. Shedd was active in civic and church work. He was one of the oldest members of the First Christian church and was an elder of the church for 37 years.

He is survived by two sons, Henry Shedd, El Paso, and Milton Shedd, Los Angeles, and a daughter, Sybil Shedd, a teacher at Coldwell school.
