

Former El Pasoan Dies on Coast

Milton C. Shedd, former El Pasoan, died in Los Angeles Aug. 1 of a heart attack, according to word received by Mrs. J. R. Kriechbaum of 3430 Fort boulevard.

Mr. Shedd came to El Paso with his pioneer parents, Mr. and Mrs. I. A. Shedd, as a child. He graduated from El Paso High School in 1904 and graduated from the Armour Institute in Chicago.

Mr. Shedd moved to Los Angeles 25 years ago where he had been engaged in the construction business. He completed many important construction projects in the West, including numerous installations for the Navy during the war.

Survivors include his widow, the former Ruth Critchett of El Paso; his mother, Mrs. I. A. Shedd; two sons, Milton C. Shedd Jr., and Irving; a daughter, Mrs. Laurence Paul, and two grandchildren, all of Los Angeles.
