

MRS. SHELTON RITES HELD AT CHURCH

**Resident of El Paso Since 1886
Taken By Death**

Funeral services for Mrs. Harriet Anna Shelton, 80, a resident of El Paso since 1886, who died at the family home, 1315 Montana St., yesterday, were to be held at 4:30 p. m. today at the First Presbyterian church with Rev. Wistor R. Smith officiating. Burial was to be in Evergreen cemetery under direction of Kaster & Maxon mortuary.

Members of the Pioneers' Assn. were to attend the services.

Mrs. Shelton was the wife of Eugene A. Shelton, postmaster under President Wilson. She was a native of Rankin county, Miss., and was a member of the Hobson family of Spanish-American war fame.

Mrs. Shelton was one of the first members of the First Presbyterian church.

She was a member of the Women's Pioneer Assn., the Y. W. C. A. and the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Shelton is survived by two daughters, Mrs. W. D. Howe and Mrs. Maury Kemp.
