

GOULD'S DAUGHTER DIES AFTER STROKE

Rail Builder's Descendant
Succumbs At 71

ROXBURY, N. Y., Dec. 21.—Mrs. Finley J. Shepard, the former Helen Gould, philanthropist and daughter of the late Jay Gould, pioneer railroad builder, died early today at her summer home at the age of 71.

She had been ill two months and in a coma 24 hours after having suffered two apoplectic strokes. Funeral services will be held here tomorrow, and again at New York City, where she will be buried.

Although she had dispensed most of the \$10,000,000 inherited from her father, who died in 1892, in various charities, she had invested the remainder so judiciously that by 1927, when she resigned as a trustee of the family estate she had tripled her original inheritance.
