

PIONEER CHINESE DIES SUDDENLY

Woo Moo Sing, a resident of El Paso's Chinatown, and the proprietor of the Pullman cafe on Mills street, died at 5:30 Monday morning, following an attack of apoplexy.

Moo Sing came to El Paso 22 years ago from San Francisco and has been prominently identified with the affairs of local Chinatown. He has had a number of business interests in this city, the Pullman cafe being his latest enterprise. He also had an interest in the Sunset cafe on El Paso street.

Sing was 60 years old, according to papers that were found in his safe at the restaurant. He is survived by his wife, who is prostrated. The funeral will be held later.
