**Member of Old McGinty Club Dead
At Hermosillo, Mex.**

Friends today were advised of the death of Harry J. Smith, July 14, at his home in Hermosillo, Mex.

Mr. Smith was the son of Capt. and Mrs. J. M. Smith, who crossed the country in 1880 in an ox wagon, stopping in Ysleta, and in 1888 settling permanently in El Paso.

Mr. Smith was employed by the First El Paso National bank as assistant cashier.

He also took a prominent part in the civic and social life of that time, and was a member of the old McGinty club, and band.

Besides his widow, he is survived by a brother, J. M. Smith, of Cananea, Sonora, Mex., and a sister, Mrs. S. J. Fennell, of La Mesa, Calif.
