

# Mrs. O. T. Smith, Longtime City Resident, Dies

Mrs. Otella B. Smith, 77, a 50-year resident of El Paso, died in her home, 1315 North El Paso Street Saturday. Mrs. Smith, born in Peoria, Kan. in 1869, moved to Big Spring, Texas in 1882.
