

### Died.

Mrs. Clara R. Stanton, wife of A. B. Stanton, died at their residences 711 North Stanton street, at about 11:15 last night. Mrs. Stanton had been suffering with tuberculosis of the brain for several months, during which she has received the constant care and attention of a devoted husband and many friends.
