

AN OLD CITIZEN GONE.

A. J. Stevens Died Last Night of Pneumonia—The Funeral.

A. J. Stevens, an old resident of El Paso, died of pneumonia at his home on Franklin street last night at 8 o'clock. He was the father of Mrs R. B. Bias and of W. G. Stevens, manager in Mexico for the Singer sewing machine company. The latter arrived in El Paso Monday to attend the bedside of his father, but was recalled to Mexico yesterday by the serious illness of his wife.

The deceased was a member of El Paso Lodge No 10, A. F. & A. M., which lodge will have charge of the funeral. He was also a member of the Grand Army of the Republic.

The remains were removed to the undertaking parlors of J. C. Ross & Co. The funeral will take place tomorrow, notice of which will be given later.
