President of Abstract Firm Follows His Son to Death

Maco Stewart, president of the Stewart Title Co. of Galveston, today had followed his son, Clegg Bisbey Stewart, to the grave. Clegg Stewart, 19, died in an El Paso sanatorium Dec. 15. Maco Stewart died yesterday at Rochester, Minn., where he had been confined in a hospital several months with a bladder ailment. He was 67.

The Stewart Title Co. has a branch office in El Paso. Maco Stewart had often visited El Paso on business, and more recently to see his son. Clegg had been undergoing treatment in El Paso for tuberculosis for five months before his death.

Mr. Stewart was a wealthy attorney and oil land owner. Several members of his family were at his bedside when he died. He had been too ill to attend the death bed of Clegg.

Survivors include Mrs. Stewart; a son, Maco; a daughter, Mrs. J. W. Fowlkes of Marfa; a sister, Mrs. W. C. Morris of Houston, and two grandchildren.
