Mrs. Bridget Sullivan, a pioneer El Paso woman, died Tuesday afternoon at 2:20 o'clock, at her home, 153 North Florence street. Mrs. Sullivan was 75 years old, had been a resident of El Paso since 1881 and was well known to many here.

Surviving her are two sons, David F. Sullivan, who is city assessor and tax collector; John T. Sullivan, who is assistant chief of the fire department, and a daughter, Mrs. C. W. Glenn, of El Paso. Two brothers also survive her, Michael Mulcahy, who is foreman of the city street department here, and David M. Mulcahy, who lives in Ireland, and two sisters, Mrs. H. Birtphistle, of Richmond, Calif., and Mrs. Ellen O'Connor, of Oakland, Calif. Mrs. Sullivan was born in Castle Island, county Kerry, Ireland. The funeral service will be held Thursday morning at 10 o'clock from the church of the Immaculate Conception and will be conducted by Rev. father Francis Roy. The burial will be in Catholic Concordia cemetery.
