

W. C. TAYLOR PASSES AWAY

Contractor Had Lived In
El Paso 47 Years.

William C. Taylor, 65, prominent building contractor, a resident here for 47 years, died at his home, 2717 East Missouri street, yesterday.

Taylor was born in Independence, Va., coming to El Paso in 1884.

Survivors are his widow, Mrs. Lydia Taylor, a daughter, Mrs. Oscar H. Gutsch, and a son, John Henry Taylor, all of El Paso; his father, John C. Taylor, of Richmond, Va., two brothers, Walter J.
