

# **O. Thorman, EP Architect, Dies Friday**

Otto H. Thorman, 77, of 4514 Hueco Ave., architect and El Paso resident for 60 years, died Friday afternoon.

Services were pending at Kaster and Maxon Downtown Chapel.

Mr. Thorman, who was reared in St. Louis, began designing Pueblo and Spanish architecture in Albuquerque, N.M., before moving to El Paso.

He and his wife celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary June 15, 1964.
