
TWO PIONEERS DIE AT THE SAME HOUR

Joseph Tibbitt, Aged 92, and Andrew William Sharpe, Aged 88, Die Early Thursday.

Two aged men, one a pioneer El Pasoan, died at the same hour Thursday morning. Joseph Tibbitt, aged 92, died at a local hospital at 2 o'clock Thursday morning. He was a pioneer of the city and at one time was owner of Orn's grove, where picnics were held in the old days. He was a member of the Masonic lodge for 57 years and a member of the El Paso lodge for 30 years. The Masons will have charge of the funeral services, the exact time of which has not yet been arranged. He has a son, Frank Tibbitt, living in El Paso and George Tibbitt, of Rincon, N.
