

Mrs. M. A. Tilton Claimed By Death In Brawley, Calif.

Mrs. M. A. Tilton, pioneer El Paso woman, died Sunday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Kenneth B. Oliver, in Brawley, Calif., friends here were advised Monday.

Mrs. Tilton left but a short time ago to visit her daughter and was ill but a short time before her death occurred. The body was forwarded from Brawley Monday and will arrive in El Paso Tuesday morning. Funeral services will be conducted in the Church of St. Clement's Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock. be made in Evergreen, beside the body of her late husband, W. S. Tilton.

Mrs. Oliver is accompanying the body of her mother to this city.

Mr. Oliver is in the vicinity of El Paso, buying cattle and making El Paso his headquarters. He has been in and out of here quite frequently for several weeks past.

Was Well Known Citizen.

Mrs. Tilton was one of the best known residents of El Paso. She and Mr. Tilton first lived here almost 30 years ago, then they moved to Denver but returned here about 18 years ago, when Mr. Tilton, became secretary of the chamber of commerce.
