Rutherford Hammers At Regan's Absenteeism

State Senator J. T. Rutherford, who blasted his congressional opponent last week in speeches throughout West Texas as a "part-time congressman" said today the incumbent's "so-called answer printed in an El Paso newspaper was ridiculous, evasive and was no true answer nor a semblance of one." Senator Rutherford, the 34-year-old ex-Marine who has served in the Texas Legislature for the last six years, said that "I still stand on my statement that my opponent is a part-time congressman." And he added: "No amount of political doubletalk, whistling in the dark or carefully worded half-truths can change the fact that he has the worst attendance record of any Texas congressman." The candidate said the Congressional Record and "other public records will show this to be true."
