

MR. MAURICE ULLMANN

He Passed Peacefully Away Surrounded by
his Children.

Mr. Maurice Ullmann died at 7:30 o'clock yesterday evening at his residence on Santa Fe street. His death was a great shock to his personal friends as well as to the community at large. He had been ill only since Friday, and even as late as Saturday he was on the street. But Saturday evening what at first was thought a slight illness developed into pleurisy and he passed away three days later.

Mr. Ullmann was one of the well known and highly respected men of the town. Coming to El Paso on the first railway train he had been continually in business. By his upright dealing he had won the esteem and confidence of his fellows. So at the end of a long life he is mourned by his acquaintances every where.

Mr. Ullmann was born in Hungary 65 years ago, but had lived in this country many years. He leaves a wife, one son and six daughters—of the latter, Mrs. S. B. Blumenthal and Mrs. E. B. Fatman. The only son, Mr. Sidney Ullmann, was associated with his father in the management of the Ullmann Furniture company. The other children are Misses Alice, Clottie, Emma and Irma.

The arrangements for the funeral have not been completed, but it will not occur before Thursday.
