Mrs. Vllas, the estimable wife of Dr. W. N. Vllas, died this morning at the family residence on North Stanton street.
While Mrs. Vllas has been ailing for a couple of years it is only within the past six months that the family felt her condition serious and only the past six weeks that they felt that the end was near. The family were pioneers of the county living a number of years at Vlela and the past ten or twelve years in El Paso.
Her death will be mourned by a wide circle of friends as well as the bereaved husband, two daughters—Mrs. J. M. Hixson and Miss Florence, and son, Walter.
The funeral will take place from the residence at 9 o'clock tomorrow morning, the services to be conducted by Rev. C. A. Hland, of the Presbyterian church, if he recovers sufficiently.
