# EL PASO GIRL ENDS OWN LIFE

## Miss Blanche Wade Found Suffering From Poison in San Antonio Park.

### LIVES A WEEK AND THEN DIES

San Antonio, Tex., April 25.—Miss Blanche Wade, of El Paso, took poison on the night of April 17, and was found in Travis Park, near the Confederate monument, whither she had been followed by friends.

She was taken to the Santa Rosa hospital, where she died Saturday night, April 24, a week later, from the poison, and the result of uremia.

The certificate of death signed by Dr. T. T. Jackson, gives uremia as the cause of death. No inquest was held.

The young girl suffered terrible agony for several days before she died. She is said to have taken 20 tablets of bi-chloride of mercury.

When first taken to the hospital she declined to give her address, but later consented to send for her mother, Mrs. E. B. McClintock, in El Paso. Mrs. McClintock arrived here in time to be with her daughter before she died and took the remains home yesterday morning.

Miss Wade left home in El Paso without informing her parents where she was going and had been in San Antonio for some time.

Miss Wade was well known to many El Pasoans. Her mother is Mrs. E. B. McClintock, of 1141 Arizona street. Mrs. McClintock was formerly Mrs. Sam Wade, and after the death of her first husband, she was married to Mr. McClintock.

Miss Wade was 20 years of age and is said to have been very handsome. She leaves a sister, Lucille, in El Paso, besides her mother and stepfather.

The physician who attended her at San Antonio was Dr. T. T. Jackson, brother of Dan M. Jackson, of El Paso.

The funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon in charge of McBean, Simmons and Carr.
