

Sam Wade Dead.

This morning Captain James H. White received a message from Consul W. W. Mills of Chihuahua saying "Tell Comstock Sam Wade died here last night." The deceased was a brother of Mrs. J. H. Comstock and was for one or more terms county surveyor of this county several years ago. A few years ago he was connected with Mr. Comstock in the management of Concordia cemetery. He was an expert civil engineer and had been working at his profession for some time in Mexico.

Two children survive the deceased: both girls, one nine and the other fourteen. The younger is with her mother, Mrs. Blanche Wade, in this city, and the elder is at school, where she has been for the past five years.

Wade had recently been employed as a civil engineer on the Chihuahua and Pacific railway and had been in Chihuahua about two years. The remains will be brought here for interment.
