

## Dr. Willis W. Waite Taken by Death

Funeral arrangements for Dr. Willis W. Waite, El Paso physician and clinical pathologist who died ~~late yesterday~~ ~~were pending today~~ with Harding and Orr. Dr. Waite was 72.

He came to El Paso in 1911 from Syracuse, N. Y., and lived at 1416 North Florence street. Dr. Waite was educated at the University of Wisconsin, his native state, and John Hopkins at Baltimore.

He was past president of the El Paso County Medical Society, a member of the Rotary Club and the Pilgrim Congregational Church of which he was a member of the Board of Directors.

Dr. Waite did extensive research on heart ailments. Up until the time of his death, he was pathologist for the City-County Hospital.

He died in a local hospital after a four-day illness.

He is survived by two sons, Willard of Oxnard, Cal., and Charles of Los Angeles; two brothers, Edwin of Washington, D. C., and John of Waukesha, Wis.; one sister, Mrs. Jesse Waite Kachel of Whitewater, Wis., and three grandchildren. Mrs. Waite died in 1936.
