

# FUNERAL SERVICE FOR E. P. PIONEER

Mrs. Elizabeth Watson In  
El Paso 48 Years

Funeral services for Mrs. Elizabeth Edwards Watson, 619 N. El Paso St., were to be held at 3 p. m. today in St. Clement's Episcopal Church, with Rev. C. H. Horner and Rev. B. M. G. Williams officiating. Burial was to be in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mrs. Watson died Sunday at her home following a long illness. She was 62, and had lived in El Paso for the last 48 years.

She was active in work at St. Clement's Church, and at the time of her death was president of the Woman's Guild there. She was treasurer of the Cloudcroft, N. M., Baby Sanatorium for a number of years.

Survivors include a son, John B. Watson, El Paso; a sister, Mrs. L. H. Tucker, El Paso; and a brother, J. W. Edwards, Piedmont, Cal.

The family has asked that no flowers be sent to the funeral services.

Mrs. Watson came to El Paso when a child, and was educated in the El Paso public schools. Her late husband, John B. Watson, was the largest grocery store owner in early El Paso.
