

PIONEER WOMAN TAKEN BY DEATH

Mrs. Charlotte Weitzig Lived
In City 50 Years

Funeral services for Mrs. Charlotte Weitzig, resident of El Paso 50 years, who died yesterday at her home, 107 North Cotton avenue, will be held today at 4 p. m. at Martin Mortuary. She was 80.

Rev. Theo H. Evers will officiate. Mrs. Weitzig was born at Hanover, Germany. She came to the United States in 1884 and to El Paso in 1887.

Mr. and Mrs. Weitzig lived the rest of their lives in their home on Cotton avenue. Mr. Weitzig died a year ago.

Survivors are two nephews and a niece, including Otto C. Hintze of El Paso. Burial will be in Evergreen cemetery.
