

ISAIAH WESTON FUNERAL.

Will Be Held Today From First M. E. Church.

Isaiah Weston, who died night before last, will be buried this morning and his funeral will be conducted from the First M. E. church at 10 o'clock.

The deceased was 74 years old. He was a native of Massachusetts, but came west in 1846 to fight in the Mexican war. He served through that war and in 1849 located at Albuquerque, but five years later came to El Paso. In 1882 he engaged in the fur business, but a few years ago he suffered a stroke of paralysis and had to give up all business pursuits. When Santa Teresa visited this city some years ago Mr. Weston called on her and declared afterward that the touch of her hands had relieved the pain he was suffering from rheumatism.

Mr. Weston leaves a wife and one son. The latter, Tom Weston, is manager for the Walz company in Mexico City.
