

Dr. Alward White Dies Here After Spinal Hemorrhage

Dr. Alward H. White, 55, of Shafter, Tex., died at an El Paso hospital yesterday morning following a brief illness. He was rushed here Thursday night after being stricken with a hemorrhage of the spinal cord, and died 12 hours later.

He was a member of a pioneer El Paso family, and a brother of Owen P. White, New York author. He came here from Colorado with his parents.
