

## DEATHS AND FUNERALS.

### Mrs. Alward White.

Mrs. Alward White, widow of Dr. Alward White, who died in this city several years ago, died this morning about ten o'clock, after a lingering illness.

Mrs. White was born in Petersburg, Va., in 1845, and was the eldest of seven children, six of whom still survive and reside in this city. They are Mrs. W. S. McCutcheon, Mrs. David M., Frank H., W. Floyd, and Jesse B. Payne. She also leaves three children who are all grown and reside in this city. One of her sons, Alward H. White, is a practicing physician in this city, while the other son, Owen P. White, is in the wholesale grain and feed business with Wm. D. Wise. The daughter Leigh is very popular in social circles.

In 1876, which was shortly after their marriage, Dr. White and his wife moved to El Paso and, with the exception of about two years which Dr. White spent in the government service in Arizona, Mrs. White has lived in this city. During her long term of residence in this city Mrs. White made a number of warm personal friends, by her kind and loving disposition, all of whom will greatly mourn her loss.

During her life Mrs. White was an active member of the Episcopal church and was also a leading member of several of the societies of that church.

The funeral services will be held in the Episcopal church tomorrow morning at nine o'clock, with Rev. Easter officiating, after which interment will be made in Evergreen cemetery.
