

Mrs. Maud White Taken By Death

Mrs. Maud Bounds White, widow of the late Zach White, pioneer El Paso builder, died today at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Paul Harvey, at 3100 Gold street. Mrs. White was 72. She had lived in El Paso 49 years.

She is survived by another daughter, Mrs. Jess Boykin of Washington, D. C.; four grandchildren, Paul Harvey Jr., and Katherine Harvey of El Paso; Charlotte Boykin of Washington, now residing in El Paso, and Mrs. Jane Loomis Kirksey of El Paso; a brother, Buck Bounds of Ysleta; a sister, Mrs. Alice Goolsby of Houston, and a nephew, Young Bounds of Separ, N. M.

Mrs. White was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

Mr. White died in January of 1932 at the age of 81. He came to El Paso in 1881, traveling part of the way by stage coach. He acquired vast acreage of land in the upper and lower valleys, and was identified with various business enterprises. He and Mrs. White were married at Sherman, to where Mr. White returned to claim his bride after settling in El Paso.
