

Rites Arranged for Mrs. Whitehead

Funeral services for Mrs. Nettie Montague Whitehead, formerly of 1015 Prospect avenue, will be held at 2 p. m., Friday in the Kaster and Maxon Chapel, Rev. B. M. G. Williams, officiating. Mr. Williams is a long-time friend of the family.

Mrs. Whitehead died recently in Long Beach, Calif., where she had lived for the past year. She was 73. She had lived in El Paso for 61 years.

She was a pioneer member of St. Clement's Church, and was one of 11 members honored in a 1945 program. They had been members of the church for 50 years. She was a past president of the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Order of Railway Conductors, and a past member of the Harmony Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star.

She is survived by her husband, Bert Whitehead of Long Beach, Calif.; two daughters, Mrs. Claudia Little, of Los Angeles, Calif., and Mrs. Earl Barnum, of Douglas, Ariz., and by a son, Bertram Whitehead, of Bisbee, Ariz.
