

Mrs. Widman, 74, Pioneer Resident, Dies In Home Here

**Came To City When Most
Of Buildings Were
Of Adobe.**

Mrs. Fannie Widman, 74 years old, a resident of El Paso for 39 years, died Saturday in her home at 701 North Ochoa street. Mrs. Widman was one of the first settlers to come to El Paso, and made it her home when it was only a border settlement, composed principally of adobe shanties.
